



Request for Expression of Interest for Assessment of Groundwater Zonation in Terai belt of Kailali, Kanchanpur, Bardiya and Banke District

1. Government of Nepal (GoN) has allocated fund *toward the cost of Assessment of Groundwater Zonation in Terai belt of Kailali, Kanchanpur, Bardiya and Banke District* and intends to apply a portion of this fund to eligible payments under the Contract for which this Expression of Interest is invited for **National consulting service**.
2. The Water Resources Research and Development Centre now invites Expression of Interest (EOI) from eligible consulting firms ("consultant") to provide the following consulting services: **Assessment of Groundwater Zonation in Terai belt of Kailali, Kanchanpur, Bardiya and Banke District**. The main objective of this study is to delineate groundwater potential zones (shallow and deep) and prepare groundwater potential map.
3. Interested eligible consultants may obtain further information at the address Water Resources Research and Development Centre, Pulchowk, Lalitpur during office hours on or before 17 October 2021 or visit e-GP system www.bolpatra.gov.np/egp or visit the client's website www.wrrdc.gov.np.
4. Consultants may associate with other consultants to enhance their qualifications.
5. Expressions of interest shall be delivered online through e-GP system www.bolpatra.gov.np/egp on or before 18 October 2021, 12:00 hours. **EOI received after deadline will be rejected. EOI shall be opened on 13:00 hours on 18 October, 2021 at the office of WRRDC, Pulchowk, Lalitpur**
6. In case the last date of obtaining and submission of the EOI documents happens to be a holiday, the next working day will be deemed as the due date but the time will be the same as stipulated.
7. EOI will be assessed based on **Qualification 40%, Experience 50%, and Capacity 10%** of consulting firm and key personnel. Based on evaluation of EOI, only shortlisted firms will be invited to submit technical and financial proposal through a request for proposal.
8. Minimum score to pass the EOI is **60**.
